### If I sign up as a delegate, what happens next? Does it cost anything?

- As a CCMS Delegate you will attend three (3) preparatory meetings prior to the annual meeting to discuss resolutions to submit to the House of Delegates at the annual meeting. Meetings are January thru March and are held at the CCMS Office immediately following the CCMS Board of Trustees meetings at 7:15 pm. The CCMS 2012 Delegate meeting dates are: January 17, February 21, and March 29, 2012.
- Delegates must attend the 2012 NSMA Annual Meeting April 27-29, 2012 at the Ravello at Lake Las Vegas.
- CCMS Delegates are reimbursed for meeting registration, hotel, food, and mileage at a rate to be determined.

### What is a resolution?

- Resolutions determine the Association’s policies and priorities.

### Can I attend the annual meeting if I am not a delegate?

YES, you can and you should for the following reasons...

1. Network with people who coordinate efforts for all legislative medicine-related issues dealing with tort reform and regulatory issues that affect physicians every day.
2. Voice your opinions and give valuable input as to the mission and purpose of our organization.
3. Exchange ideas with physicians from throughout the state and from many specialties about many topics—from problems with hospitals or insurance companies, to public health issues.

### How does the society determine the number of county delegate seats?

- Each county society is allotted one (1) seat per every 20 members
- CCMS is entitled to approximately 30 representatives in the House of Delegates—the final number of seats are determined by NSMA 45 days preceding the annual session.
